In accordance with Kansas Administrative Regulations 28-16-57a through 63, 28-18-1 through 17, 28-18a-1 through 31 and 33, 28-16-150 through 154, 28-46-7, and the authority vested with the State by the administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, various draft water pollution control documents (permits, notices to revoke and reissue, notices to terminate) have been prepared and/or permit applications have been received for discharges to waters of the United States and the state of Kansas for the class of discharges described below.

The proposed actions concerning the draft documents are based on staff review, applying the appropriate standards, regulations, and effluent limitations of the state of Kansas and the Environmental Protection Agency. The final action will result in a Federal National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Authorization and/or a Kansas Water Pollution Control permit being issued, subject to certain conditions, revocation, and reissuance of the designated permit or termination of the designated permit.

Enterprise Products Operating LP (Enterprise) is authorized to store liquefied hydrocarbon products including butane, isobutane, propane, natural gasoline, ethane/propane mix, and mixed natural gas liquids (NGLs) in underground caverns that are solution mined in the Hutchinson Salt member of the Wellington formation at the Hutchinson Underground Storage Facility (HUGS). Brine ponds within the Hutchinson Kansas facility boundary are used for brine containment and transfer of brine throughout the Hutchinson Underground Storage facility.

Persons wishing to comment on or object to the draft documents and/or permit applications must submit their comments in writing to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) if they wish to have the comments or objections considered in the decision-making process.
